A SUCCESS STORY

A Work Coach at the Peterborough Job Centre referred Mary to the Health & Care Sector Work Academy (HCSWA). Mary explained that she had been living in temporary accommodation and was hoping that if she achieved employment within the health and care sector she would be able to move to rented accommodation. Before starting the course, Mary said that she had 'a clear sense of the future direction' and that this course would help her towards her eventual goal of being a nurse in the NHS.

While on the course, Mary was supported by her mentor to apply for a Care Assistant role and to update her CV. Mary achieved a paid position at Park House Nursing Home. Mary then moved to rented accommodation.

Mary said that the course helped her to 'get a job and develop skills in the care sector'. Mary's ultimate aim is to attend more training to enable her to be a nurse and she would still like to be able to volunteer in her spare time.








