

Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Child Safeguarding Level 3: Curriculum Map of Training Resources in Primary Care

(Adapted for General Practice from 'Safeguarding Children and Young People: Roles and Core Competencies', Intercollegiate Document, January 2019)

12 hours training over 3 years, with 50% participatory and 50% non-participatory training. Education and learning opportunities should be multi-disciplinary with some inter-agency input desirable, and delivered internally and externally. It should include personal reflection and scenario-based discussion, drawing on case studies, serious case reviews, and lessons from research and audit. This should be appropriate to the speciality and roles of participants. Organisations should consider encompassing safeguarding/child protection learning within regular multi-professional and/or multi-agency staff meetings, vulnerable child and family meetings, clinical updating, clinical audit, reviews of critical incidents and significant unexpected events and peer discussions.
