# **FELLOWSHIP IN GENERAL PRACTICE**

The Fellowship offers a 2-year programme of support for newly qualified GPs and GPNs beginning careers in General Practice. Applications can be submitted for any new or already in post GP or Nurse, who qualified within the last 12 months and who is employed in a substantive role. Funding to practices has increased, with backfill now paid at the rate of salary + 30% uplift for on-costs, and there's an additional contribution towards the cost of in-house mentoring for GPs on the scheme.
