Clinical peer support	GP in the PCN - or could be provided in a group across the locality to create a group large enough.	Monthly group session with a GP to discuss clinical aspects of cases.	 ✓ Understand their role as part of the wider clincial team/MDT ✓ Understand primary care ✓ Put clinical context to their cases
		Urgent clinical queries on the day as per the practice arrangement (usual GP, duty GP etc)	 ✓ Ensure appropriate utilisation (appropriate cases, and not under utilisted) ✓ Guidance on difficult cases
		➤ Ideally a group of 6-8 link workers	 ✓ Ask questions ✓ Understand the systems they work in ✓ Understand what the boundaries of their roles are – eg when it's not their job!
Integrated locality support	"Integrated huddles" with other local organisations eg Local Authority, other NHS organisations Organised by the PCLRs	Fortnightly or monthly forum	✓ Supporting personalised care roles to learn, develop and build relationships across the locality.
