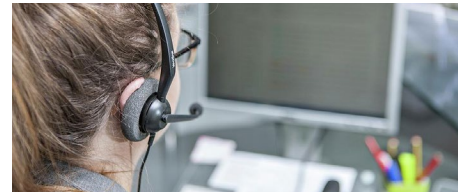

**Thu 03 October 2024**

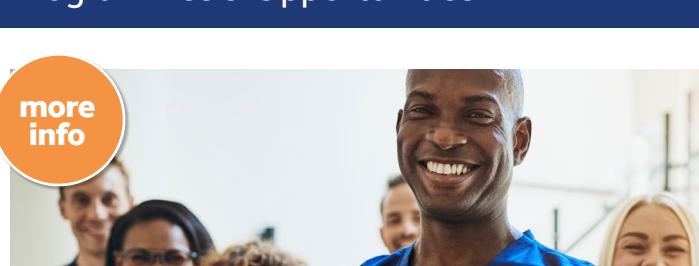

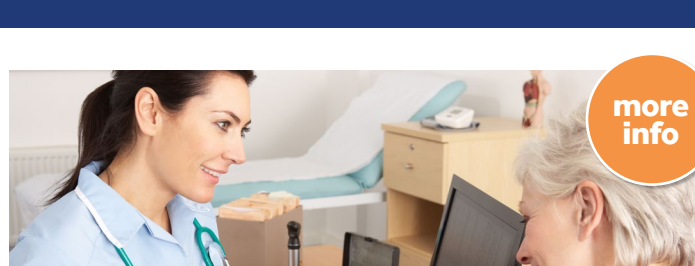

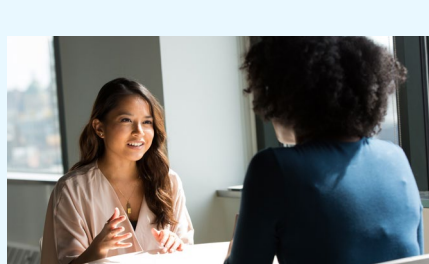
#### GP STAFF SURVEY

The NHS Long-Term Workforce Plan commits to encouraging all NHS organisations to have staff feedback processes in place to ensure staff feedback is listened to and acted upon. Points can be collected via the QOF QI module for collecting staff lists and encouraging response to the survey. This is an important step in understanding the better experience of people working in general practice and then working with you to identify what changes can be made to the support teams. The survey will be carried out on behalf of organisations by an independent and impartial survey contractor, Picker. Survey responses are anonymised and subject to the highest standards of confidentiality protocols so what respondents say is kept absolutely anonymous.
