Further dates for the Health and Wellbeing Guardians and Supporting Senior Executive Leaders Community of Practice sessions have been announced for 2024/25.

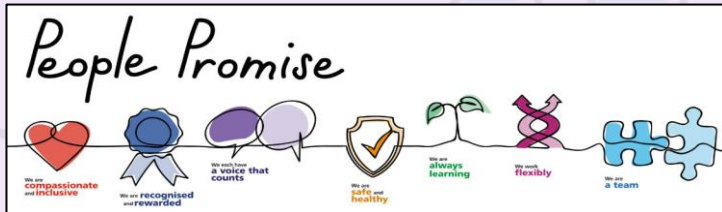
All sessions take place on Thursdays, 2.30pm – 4pm on the following dates:
