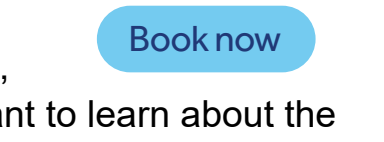
## 2025 C&P ICS Practice Learning Awards

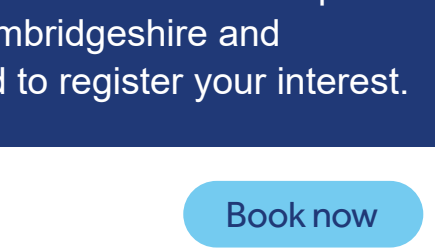
