THE CONSENT PAGE

On the consent page, you must select an option and will need to provide a reason for accessing the patient record. Once you have provided the information you will have access to the patient record.

From the consent page you will see the screen to the right. From here you can access patient data via the Clinical Document Viewer (CDV Tree) on the left hand side or by using the dashboard tiles on the right hand side.
