

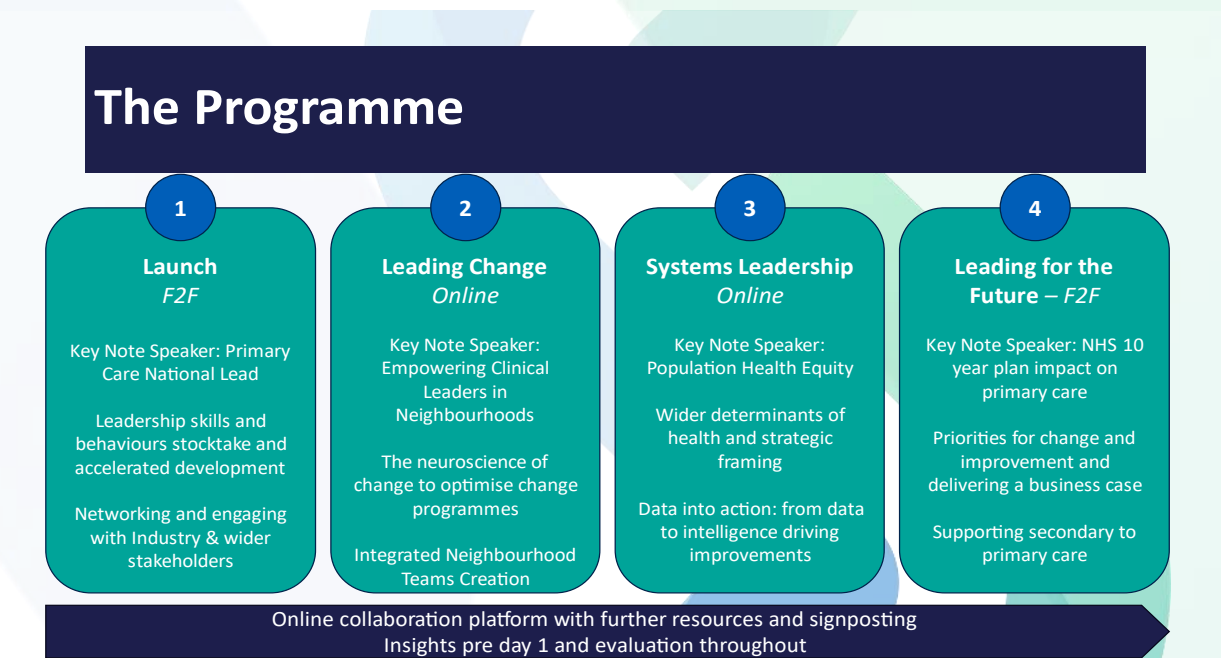
Primary Care is front and centre of many aspects of the future NHS Plan and the “big three shifts”. However, we recognise that Primary Care is pressured and very stretched at this point in our local healthcare systems. Our future will clearly require world class GP leaders to help with the necessary improvement programmes for the future.

This programme is designed to **support GPs ready to lead change at scale** - across Integrated Care Systems, Primary Care Networks and across neighbourhoods - providing the skills, insights, and networks to step confidently into more senior **leadership roles**. This initiative is supported by the NHSE Primary Care Directorate and complements their Peer Ambassador workstreams. We aim to support up to 30 **motivated GP leaders across England's 42 Integrated Care Systems, with 20 places fully sponsored**.

About the Programme:

This 7-month programme includes 4 **Full Training Days** – exploring effective clinical leadership across complex systems bringing in expertise from a diverse background including Industry/business experts, change experts, system leaders and finance experts.

Programme Overview & Dates



Participants will be able to bring **a live problem or challenge** along their journey where they can shape their approach and create a narrative and rationale for change to deliver beneficial impact and showcase their journey.

- Day 1 - Face to Face - Westminster London - 23rd July 2025
- Day 2 - Virtual Online Day - 16th September 2025
- Day 3 - Virtual Online Day - 20th November 2025
- Day 4 - Face to Face - Manchester - 21st January 2026

Expected Outcomes:

- The establishment of an NHS CLN GP Leaders Network with a culture of solution finding.
- To create a genuine nexus of two-way learning to assist national policy makers in succeeding with their required duties to develop solutions and see these described through the new NHS Plan as it is developed.
- Empowered GP Leaders Network using a distributed leadership model to continue to support.
- Improvements in self-reported leadership capabilities and confidence.
- GP Leaders delivering real change.
- Measurable improvements reported from participants change programmes benefiting their local populations.

Cost:

Free for the first 20 applications, £1,500 per delegate thereafter (this is a reduced price as this programme is subsidised by NHS CLN & its Strategic Affiliates)
