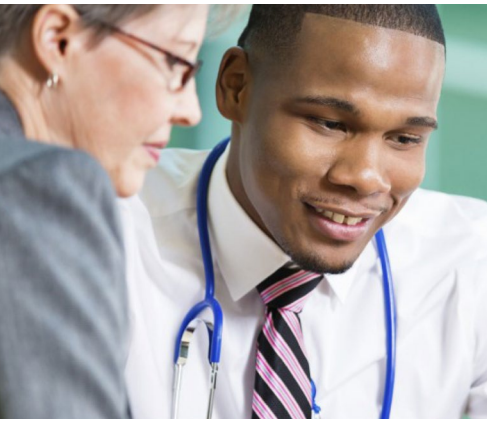


Introduction to Contraception Webinar

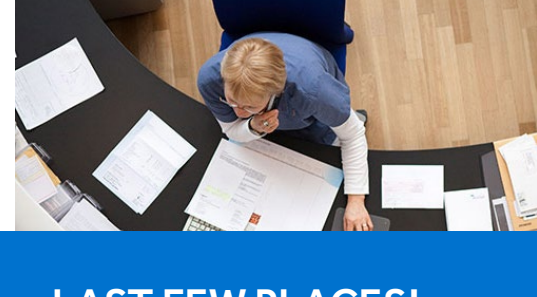

Mandatory Training on Learning Disability and Autism

The Health and Care Act 2022 introduced a statutory requirement that CQC registered providers must ensure their staff receive learning disability and autism training appropriate to their role. Cambridgeshire and Peterborough ICB have commissioned a specialist Training Network to deliver training that meets these requirements on behalf of the system this year and have allocated General practice staff priority booking access to 30 places each month.
