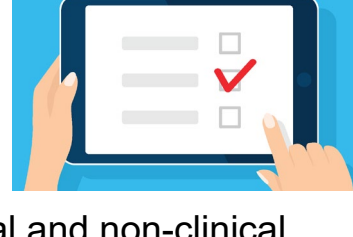


Please tell us what you need!

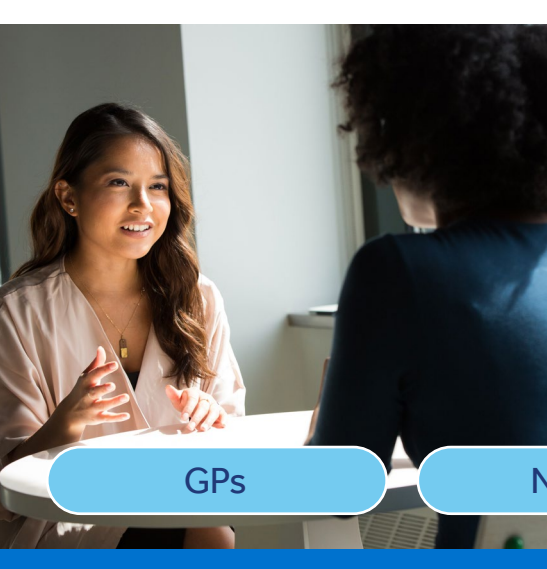
Group Coaching Supervision for Health & Wellbeing Coaches

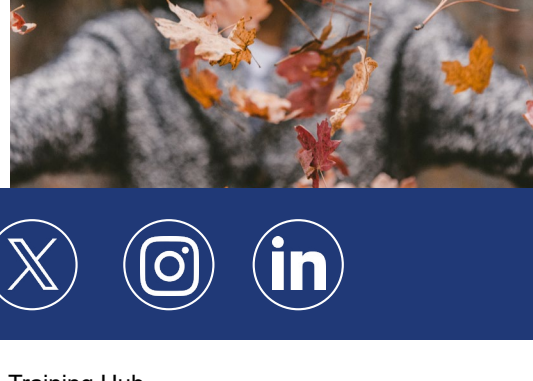
