Immunisation and Injection training for HCAs and Pharmacy Techs (Flu, Pneumococcal and B12)

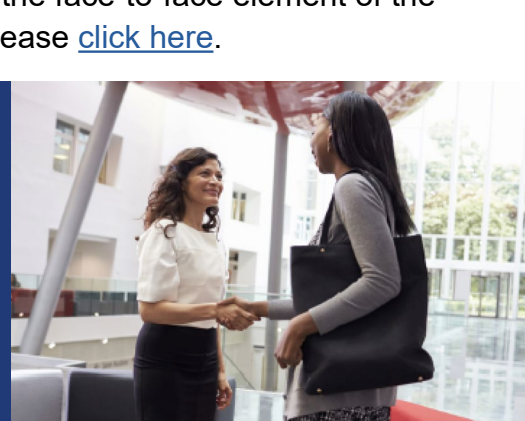
Thursday 02 July & Wednesday 09 July

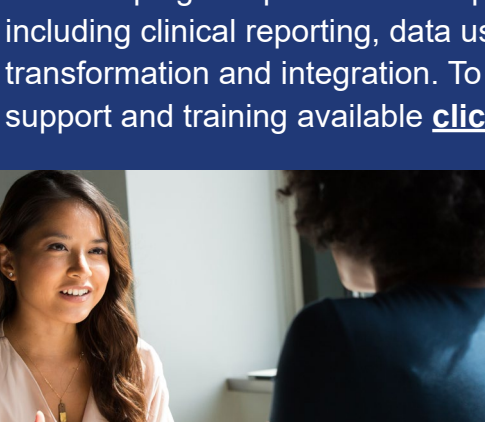
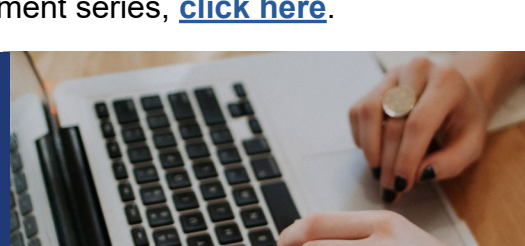
