Mandatory Training on Learning Disability and Autism

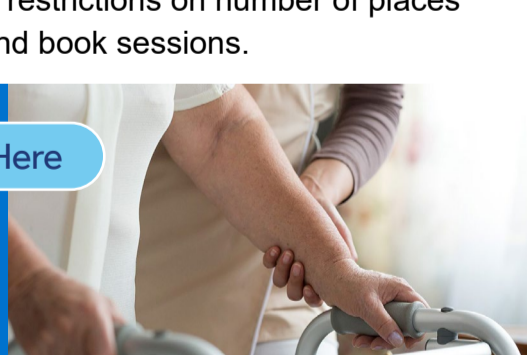

Summarising Medical Records Virtual Training

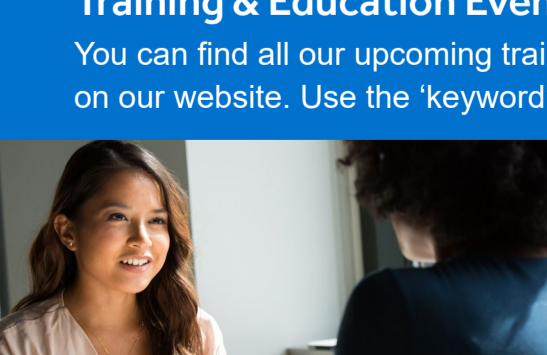
Thursday 10 September, 09:15-12:30
